Introduction

This edition of the After-School Clubs booklet reflects changes we have made in the clubs we offer, based on feedback and our desire to bring more and varied opportunities into the programme. Our clubs provision is constantly evolving as we seek fresh and inspiring ways to extend and enrich children's learning and respond dynamically to their interests.

At the heart of our ambition for Blackheath Prep is our commitment to providing the very best for all children to enjoy and achieve. This includes having the widest possible range of opportunities both within and beyond the curriculum. We offer extra-curricular opportunities through various types of provision delivered by school staff, external providers and independent clubs, all with a view to increasing the range of experiences that children have, enabling them to make informed choices for adult life. Activities are designed to be fun and cater for a wide variety of interests.

We want to offer the scope for each and every child to find a passion, develop a talent, spark an interest or simply find pleasure in doing an activity with others. After-school clubs are a fantastic way of achieving this and we are excited to offer a wide range of clubs. This booklet outlines all of the after school clubs we have available.

Some internal clubs are heavily oversubscribed every term and children may be placed on a waiting list for these clubs. Whilst every effort is made to ensure that children are able to enjoy their choice of clubs, this is not always possible.

Clubs may be cancelled if there are not enough participants.

We hope you will take time to explore what is on offer and encourage your child to try something new or continue taking part in a firm favourite.

We will be using the online myEVOLVE booking system for all internal clubs, as well as Tennis. Other external club providers have various means of booking which are detailed in this booklet.

Internally run club preferences can be selected immediately via myEVOLVE on MySchoolPortal.

External club bookings will open on Friday 22 November at 8.00pm.

All club selections must be made by 8.00pm on 7 December 2024.

Club allocations will be made by Monday 16 December 2024.

Please note that the clubs run by outside agencies require direct booking and payment to secure your place. The charge for all internal clubs run by staff are charged through the myEVOLVE platform. Occasionally, fixtures and other events will mean that children may miss a club and in these circumstances, we regret that we are unable to provide a refund. The PE Department will make every effort to schedule fixtures on allocated Games afternoons to minimise disruption to after-school activities so please do bear this in mind when booking your clubs. Year 4 Games takes place on Tuesday afternoon, Year 3 Games take place on Wednesday afternoon, Year 5 Games takes place on Thursday afternoon and Year 6 Games take place on Friday afternoon.

The school's Spring term calendar will be available on My School Portal. If you feel that too many sessions of a club are likely to be missed due to other events, you have the option to change or cancel your bookings at the start of the Spring Term. No changes will be accepted once the clubs programme has commenced on Monday 13 January 2025.



Important Points to Note

With effect from 1 January 2025, new legislation being introduced by the Government will require the School to apply VAT at 20% to the cost of co-curricular clubs and activities provided by the School. The exceptions to this will be Breakfast Club and Late Stay which will remain exempt from VAT as they are deemed as welfare only arrangements (i.e. there is no element of tuition, learning or coaching).

The new cost for internally run clubs effective from 1 January 2025 be £10.93 per session, inclusive of VAT.

As there are 9 sessions of internally run club sessions due to take place this term, the cost per term for internal clubs will be £98.37 (inclusive of VAT) for the Spring Term.

External clubs are charged at variable rates, which are detailed in this handbook.

Learn to code with the world's most popular block-building game. Coders will learn new programming concepts and mathematics concepts each week with Minecraft Education Edition. They will be given projects that help build problem-solving skills using Microsoft MakeCode (and potentially Python or JavaScript for the older year groups) in a safe, single-player, 3D Minecraft world. Topics will build up each week with co-ordinate geometry, conditionals, loops, variables, functions and much more!

Lego Robotics and Coding

Build and code your own robots! In this club, the children will learn about all types of components that are used in building robots: processors, motors, sensors, displays etc.. Each week, they will use these to build and programme their robots. They will be given a set of challenges to complete each week. Applications will vary from smart homes and automated machines to rescue bots and space rovers. The pre-prep children will be working with Lego Wedo 2.0 and Lego Spike Essential whilst the prep children will use Lego Spike Prime, BBC Micro:Bit, MakeyMakey, Sphero BOLT etc.


Fencing Club
